
Tons of CO2-equivalent saved per year



- CO2-equivalent (CO2-e) allows other greenhouse gas emissions to be expressed in terms of CO2, based on their relative Global Warming Potential (GWP). CO2 has a GWP of 1 and methane has a GWP of 25.
- The amount of CO2-e saved by each action is based on an average for developed countries.
- CO2-e saved by not creating a new human is found by multiplying an average person's annual emissions by 5.7 to account for descendants' emissions: 10.28 tons x 5.7 = 58.6 metric tons per year. In the US, 16.5 tons x 5.7 = 94 metric tons saved.
